- What good thing must I do to get eternal life?
 - There is only One who is good Who?
- If you want to enter life, keep the commandments
 - You shall not murder
 - You shall not commit adultery
 - You shall not steal
 - You shall not give false testimony
 - Honor your father and mother
 - Love your neighbor as yourself

MATTHEW 19 – A CHECKLIST FOR ETERNAL LIFE?

TEN COMMANDMENTS - EXODUS 20:1-17

1. You shall have no other God before me

- 3. You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God
- 4. Remember the Sabbath
- 5. Honor your father and mother
- 6. You shall not murder

MATTHEW 19:16-30

- If you want to enter life, keep the commandments
 - You shall not murder (Ex. 20:13)
 - You shall not commit adultery (Ex. 20:14)
 - You shall not steal (Ex. 20:15)
 - You shall not give false testimony (Ex. 20:16)
 - Honor your father and mother (Ex. 20:12)
 - Love your neighbor as yourself (Lev. 19:18)
 - If you want to be perfect, sell your possessions and give to the poor
 - Then come, follow me

MATTHEW 22:34-40

- What is the greatest commandment?
 - Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind (Deut. 6:5)
 - Love your neighbor as yourself (Lev. 19:18)

MARK 12:28-34

- Jesus saw he answered wisely
 - You're not far from the kingdom of God
 - What was missing?
 - Acknowledging Jesus as Messiah Savior
- Matthew 19:21 Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."



Saved by true faith - belief in Jesus and his sacrifice

THE GOSPEL

- Eternal life = faith in Jesus = Grace
- Love for God = follow his commands
 - Trying to follow his commands ≠ Eternal life
- > Following his commands is the effect, not the cause of our salvation
 - ▶ Romans 3-8
 - Ephesians 2
