WHEN JESUS QUOTES

PSALM 22 – PSALM AND PROPHECY

- My God, my God, why have you forsaken me (Psalm 22:1)
- All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads. (Psalm 22:7)
- "He trusts in the Lord," they say,
 "let the Lord rescue him. (Psalm 22:8)
- They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment (Psalm 22:18)

- My God, my God, why have you forsaken me (Matthew 27:46)
- Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads (Matthew 27:39)
- He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God (Matthew 27:43)
- When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots. (Matthew 27:35)

WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?

- Matthew 27:46- My God my God why have you forsaken me?
 - Forsake: Abandon, leave behind, leave
 - Human level
 - Spiritual level

GOD MADE HIM WHO HAD NO SIN...

- 2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
 - Isaiah 53:9 "He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth."
 - Hebrews 4:15 'For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are -yet he did not sin"
 - Hebrews 7:26 "Such a high priest truly meets our need—one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens"
 - > 1 Peter 2:22 "He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth"
 - I John 3:5 "But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And in him is no sin"
 - John 8:29 "The one who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases him."

... TO BE SIN FOR US

- Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.
- Isaiah 53:11 ...and he will bear their iniquities...
- Isaiah 53:12 ...For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors...



- Snakes to Israel represented death, sin, judgement
 - But, they were saved by looking at it
- Jesus BECAME (took on) all sin
 - We are saved by looking to Him

JESUS' DEATH

- What it wasn't
 - Martyr
 - Injustice
- What it is
 - Sacrifice

JESUS' DEATH

- Get rid of the old yeast, so that you may be a new unleavened batch as you really are.
 For Christ, our <u>Passover lamb</u>, has been sacrificed. (1 Cor. 5:7 NIV)
- * For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a <u>sin offering</u>." (Romans 8:3 NIV)
- Yet it was the Lord 's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the Lord makes his life an <u>offering for sin</u>, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the Lord will prosper in his hand (Isaiah 53:10 NIV)
- Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a <u>fragrant offering and sacrifice to</u> <u>God</u>." (Ephesians 5:1-2 NIV)
- "He is the <u>atoning sacrifice</u> for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world." (1 John 2:2)

ACTS 2:22-36

- Acts 2:22-24 Jesus was put to death on the cross, but God raised him from the dead.
- Acts 2:25-28 Psalm 16:8-11 David writing: You will not abandon me to the grave, nor will you let your Holy One see decay
- Acts 2:29-35 Assured crowd that David died and was buried in a tomb (had not risen).
 - David couldn't be speaking of himself. He was speaking of Jesus' resurrection!
- Acts 2:36 Therefore God has made Jesus both Lord and Christ

PSALM 22:22-31

They will proclaim his righteousness, declaring to a people yet unborn: He has done it!
